Car Rider Information



We ask that all SCE families follow the below procedures for car rider line:

- Per our student handbook, car riders should not arrive before 8:00am for arrival or 3:10pm for dismissal.
- Any arrival after 8:45am will be considered tardy. Parents must walk their children into the school to sign in a student who is tardy.
- Anyone picked up prior to 3:45 will be counted as an early dismissal. Please bring your ID when picking up a child.
- * Walking up to pick up your child will only be for students walking home with a parent.
- Please have your orange car rider tag placed in a visible area during dismissal.
- Please remain in the car and school personnel will assist the students to their vehicle during dismissal.

Arrival and Dismissal Information

All parents/guardians must wait until 3:10 to enter the campus and form a line to pick-up a student using the car rider process for dismissal. This applies to any area on campus.

We ask that all vehicles in the afternoon pickup line have the car rider tag clearly visible with the names of all children you are picking up. Each family will receive complimentary signs. Additional signs may be picked up in the office. Please make sure you bring your ID. All students should be picked up in the car rider line. If you walk up to get your child, you will be sent to the office to sign your child out. Every 3rd sign out will be 1 early dismissal.

Best Practices for Arrival to Support the Efficient Flow of Traffic for Everyone

- **Arrival Balance** – The current wait time between 8:00 and 8:25 is less than 2 minutes as traffic is continuously flowing. It is important that more students arrive between this time to create a better arrival balance. Students not in the building by 8:45 will be considered tardy.
- **Exit Vehicles Quickly (right side only)** – It is important that students are prepared to exit vehicles quickly with all things ready for the school day. Please pull all the way forward to eliminate gaps in the line. Students need to exit at the first location on the sidewalk instead of waiting to get to the front of the line.
- **Limit Walk-Ups and Gym Lot Use** - The gym parking area and walk-ups should only be used in rare situations involving temporary needs.

Did You Know?



National Fire Prevention Week falls during the week of October 9th each year. It commemorates The Great Chicago Fire of 1871. The Great Chicago Fire was one of the worst disasters in U.S. history. The fire began on October 8th, 1871 and burned for two days

until October 10th. The fire completely destroyed the heart of Chicago including an area four miles long and nearly a mile wide. Over 17,000 buildings were destroyed and 100,000 people were left homeless from the fire. No one is sure how many people died in the fire, but estimates put the number of dead at around 300. The total property damage from the fire was put at \$222 million which is over \$4 billion when adjusted to 2015 dollars.
